1. How is your building of your minibike for this year going? Some of you may still have got last year's 50cc MB, or perhaps can borrow a friends MB and have fun refreshing those riding skills. For those who wish to test out their minibikes, gain riding experience, try out new sidecar team work, then practice sessions are available on the following dates on the back circuit at Manfeild, entrance via Kawakawa Road. Cost \$10 a day. The following Saturdays 9.00am to 12.00 am. 28 July, 11 August, 25 August, 8, 15, 22 September. Some of these dates will probably be cancelled due to bad conditions. 2. On line registration for the Mini Moto Race meeting at Manfeild Chris Amon circuit on 15-17 October to open on this website soon.
3. Entry fee is the same as last year at \$35.00. No matter how many bikes you have built and plan to ride. E.g. 50cc, 70cc, sidecar.
4. Deadline for payment is Friday 7 September. Bank account number on the online form. For those running late there is a late entry fee of \$50.00 and an absolute deadline of 14 September.
5. Those running late after the 7 September deadline will not likely get their name in the race programme as it will be on its way to the printers but you will be able to race if entry received before 14 September.
6. This year online entries available for the new electric Road and Motard classes E50Road and E50 Motard.

10. Those who still have access to **water cooled Minibikes**, and those with **modified Mini Bikes** will be able to race in October and can be catered for in the **prototype** class. Numbers entering will determine the number of heats.
